Have you ever thought of taking a year to explore a unique way of life? Perhaps you would consider being a Live-in Residential Counselor in L'Arche Sudbury!

L'Arche is an international federation of communities, each centered on the gifts and the needs of women and men who live with an intellectual disability. Founded by Canadian Jean Vanier, there are 127 L'Arche communities in 30 countries on five continents. Every year each L'Arche community welcomes “assistants” who come to live, work and create home with people with an intellectual disability. As a L'Arche assistant you can:

- ◆ **Gain extraordinary experience.** You will have opportunities to teach and learn new skills, develop communication abilities, manage projects and be part of a team. You may discover that the most significant learning takes place in the context of human relationship.
- ◆ **Live community** with all different kinds of people. You may find living with others the most challenging and transforming element of the L'Arche experience. Often called “the school of the heart,” L'Arche is a dynamic example of how people of different intellectual capacity, social origin and culture can live together.
- ◆ **Make friends** with a diverse group of people who come from all parts of Canada – and all over the world. There are 25 L'Arche communities across Canada from Vancouver Island to the Maritimes.

L'Arche Sudbury is part of this international federation. As a live-in residential counselor in L'Arche Sudbury, you will be asked to assist with the completion of daily activities, assist with household maintenance, meal preparation, shopping, community activities, etc. You are also expected to provide support and guidance for emotional needs. L'Arche Sudbury has three homes, each home has its own unique atmosphere and gifts and challenges. **As a live-in residential counselor you will be trained** in many of these practical skills and both receive and provide timely and ongoing feedback. You will have an opportunity to attend meetings and community events and foster a spirit of welcome that is instrumental in developing and maintaining supportive relationships. As a live-in assistant you will come to realize that whatever someone's gifts or limitations, all people are bound together in a common humanity. That's what L'Arche is all about!
