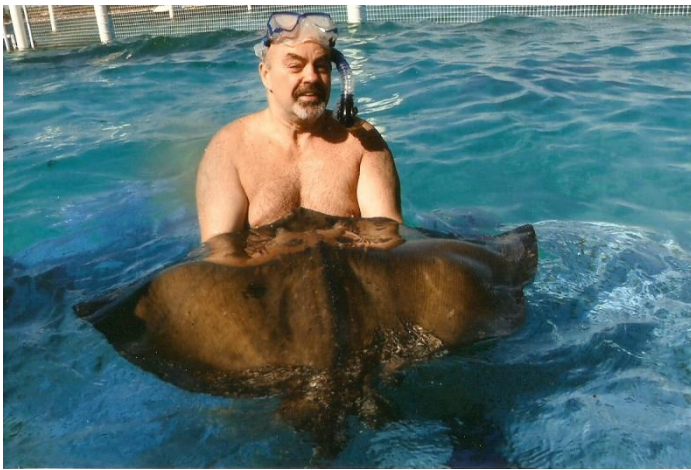

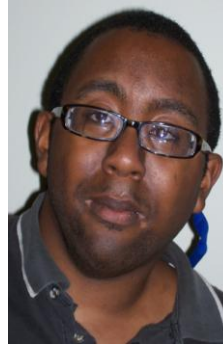
## SOLIDARITY VISITS
