

After a mutual dialogue with Jennifer McCauley, the Community Leader of L'Arche Sudbury and John Guido the Regional Coordinator of L'Arche Ontario, it was agreed that I would step away from my current role in the community for approximately a year. It is common practice in L'Arche for past Community Leaders to step away from L'Arche for a period of time, to allow the new Community Leader the time and space to settle into their new role.

As a confirmed Member of L'Arche Sudbury, I will continue to participate fully in the communal life of L'Arche. I will be in relationship with community members and participate fully in the celebrations and the spiritual life of the community during the year. I will continue being a full member of the community but for the duration of the year I am away I will not carry any formal or informal leadership role.

My time away will provide the current leadership an opportunity to exercise their gifts without the everyday shadow of the past Community Leader. It would also give me the opportunity to take some time to reflect on my 10 years as community leader and to work towards and achieve some personal goals. At the end of my one year leave of absence, it is my hope and the community's that I will return to a role that is beneficial for both myself and the community.

As I step away from my role in L'Arche Oct 1, I am reminded of the following verse *“And what does God require of you?
