***As geese flap their wings, they create an uplift for the bird following. By flying together in a V formation, the flock's flying range is 71% greater than that of any bird flying alone.

When we share a common direction and sense of Community, we can get where we are going more quickly and easily because we are traveling on the energy of one another.

***When a goose gets sick or wounded, 2

geese drop out of formation and follow it down to help and protect it. They stay with it until it is able to fly again. They then launch out on their own to find another formation or to catch up with the flock.

When we learn the value of teamwork, we stand by each other in challenging times. Let us fly in formation and remember to drop back to help those who need it.
