Hello from Claire

Hello there again. We are back from Paris and very happy with our 8 days there. We took a few tours to see all the major sites, even one “Paris by night” to see the city of lights. Some in the group went to Normandy to visit the sites and beaches where our Canadians fought so bravely and so many lost their lives, we attended a “Moulin Rouge” performance and we were all enchanted with it. We recommend it to anyone coming to Paris. One of our favorite corners was the Latin Quarter in the Sorbonne University area. We walked the narrow cobblestone streets eventually got lured in by one of the merchants calling to us. We went in and had couscous. We returned another night for a cheese fondue and raclette.’ Both are traditional dishes. One day, we went shopping a la Parisienne at the Galleries Lafayette. As we already knew, the prices were well beyond us. A pair of jeans for 195 Euros (about 225 Can.) We just walked around and took photos of the beautiful stained glass mosaic dome and the decor. On the Sat. we took a train to Compiègne, close to Trosly and we were met by some L’Arche people that I had lived with some 35 yrs. ago. We had a meal in one of the homes and then, they took us for a tour to see the area to see the chateaux and the tour where Joan of Arc

was held in captivity the night before she was burnt at the stake.

Now we are back in Portugal at our little apt. We woke up this morning to a cloudy sky and the first rain since we got here. The temp is between 18 to 26 with lots of sun. Hope that all is well with you all. Will write again in a few weeks. Love, Claire
