In 2021, members of L'Arche Sudbury worked together to develop the strategic priorities we wanted to focus on over a 4year term. It is with great pride that I share the successes thus far and ask for your continued support as we embark on the final year of our Strategic Plan.

"Go Deeper" - We have invested in the development of individuals though skills assessments and training. We introduced the home "Jericho" is running smoothly. We have a community wide program to teach the Core Values to all. We proudly participated with Tamarack Institute on Asset Mapping and Community Engagement. One of our Core Members was chosen as a Youth Leader representative for L'Arche Canada and received training on advocacy and leadership through King's College. Another member represented us as a delegate on Parliament Hill, speaking to affordable housing needs for people with intellectual disabilities. We will continue to focus our efforts on investing in the members of our community in the year ahead.

"Go Out" - We have strengthened partnerships with our government officials, fellow sister agencies, individuals, and families in the city. Through the support of Petryna Advertising, we had a very successful awareness campaign "L'Arche is Home," where we spread information about the mission of L'Arche and have seen greater recognition of our community.

We have seen increased donations, hosted wonderful fundraising events, recruited more staff and volunteers, and have expanded our number of Board Members.

"Go Within"-We successfully renovated the property rented from Guardian Angel at 1173 Rideau Street and welcomed 2 young individuals into alternative residential living spaces, one who lives in their own place in the city and one who lives in the apartment in the basement of Bethany. We continue to listen to the voices of our Community Participation Supports Program and look for different activities offered in house and in the wider city for people to participate in. We also continue to work tirelessly to try and make the dream of "L'Arche Sudbury Place" a multi-use building to be constructed on the property we own in Minnow Lake a reality. Much work has been done at the Local, Provincial and National levels of government to secure the funding needed and we continue to work towards our goals.
